

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APPETIZER

On Noirmoutier Island, you have the world's most extraordinary shellfishing site... The Gois itself. Aurelia is taking us there!

"Here, you learn shellfishing at the same time as dancing! I started shellfishing on the Gois at a very young age. It must be said that it's secure enough, an ideal place to make children discover shellfishing... and above all it's a very fine place! To make the most of it, you have to get there one hour and a half before and head back one hour after slack tide. When tide coefficients are high, the sea recedes further and so, especially, clam holes are easier to see. Clams lie two to three centimetres in the mud. You will recognise them by their two converging holes. Of course, we're not professionals, and therefore we're shellfishing with a knife and in compliance with authorised limits: a 3.5-cm minimum size and 3 kg maximum quantity per person for clams. On the Gois, you also have periwinkles and cockles.

A WORLD-UNIQUE SITE



What makes the difference here is, of course, in the first place, the magnificent environment of Bourgneuf Bay. The car traffic on the causeway also has a lot of charm. But above all there's a very special atmosphere and a great silence. You also have the advantage of great visibility: you can see very well when the tide comes in, it's very reassuring. You can even fish while staying very close to the causeway. Personally, I prefer the off-season, it's quieter. I like to go to the Gois by bike with my husband and the kids or friends, and then walk two or three kilometres and start shellfishing. You can get back by the road... or ride along the sea wall of the Sebastopol polder, it's a really magnificent place. Then, you need to carefully let the clams soak in several baths of fresh water. But there are a thousand ways of enjoying them: by throwing them in a pan with garlic or cream, preparing them with pasta... But I prefer eating them raw with bread and slightly salted butter!"

AN APPETIZER TO BE SAVOURED

Much more than a wonderful area for shellfishing, the Gois, with its 4.150 km-long submersible causeway, is chiefly the most famous of the accesses to Noirmoutier Island. An ancestral passage, reinforced and developed from the 19th century onwards, it offers the visitor respecting its timing the promise of a unique experience to reach the island, by car, at wave level...

From the harbour of L'Herbaudière, Alexandre Couillon, the double-starred chef of *La Marine*, sublimes the exceptional local produce with infinite delicacy.

"I go and get my fish every morning at the fish auction market with the privilege of being able to choose what I feel like cooking, of plunging my hands in the ice, of seeing the fish, of smelling it, of checking its extreme freshness... At *La Marine*, we have no favourite fish: what's guiding us is seasonality and freshness condition. We take what we find and if the expected fish is not available, we adapt! Since we started out with my wife, we've banked on ennobling and working all fishes, sardines just as well as horse mackerel, John Dory, pollock, line-caught sea bass or sole... Cooking will then give different textures. Some fish need to be grilled or smoked rather than roasted or fried. Others are almost raw. A line-caught sea bass just off the boat will be sublimated by being just laid on pine cone embers, accompanied with a garden honey vinaigrette dressing. The ocean surrounding us is an inexhaustible source of inspiration.

TASTING MENU



AN AUTHENTIC AND GENUINE CUISINE

Of course, we're fond of oysters. Raw, cooked or grilled, in cream or in emulsion, they will take on a more or less iodine-rich taste and a different texture according to seasons. Our whole cuisine is enhanced with fleur de sel salt: it imparts last-minute crispness to a caramel or a chocolate cream. Actually, we offer the traveller an authentic and genuine cuisine so that he may find in his plate the island he's just travelled through. Therefore, we always favour the vegetables and fruit of our kitchen garden over avocados, pineapples or mangos. The approach is the same with spices, absent from our cuisine! Instead, we use aniseed leaves, wild fennel and bay leaves which were already used by the Noirmoutier inhabitants of yesteryear to flavour pastries."

Welcome to a gourmet island! With such a talented terroir where land and ocean meet, the cooks vie to outdo each other in talent and imagination to tickle the taste buds. Traditional or innovative, simple or refined, coming in every style and for all budgets, the Noirmoutier cuisine has first and foremost the taste of authenticity. **PINCH
OF SALT**



From her salterns, which she runs with her husband, salt maker Morgane sees the seasons and visitors go by.

“People who venture here come by bike and are always very respectful. They move around gently and often stop to look at the scenery. We have very pleasant exchanges. Indeed, quickly enough you can feel if they want to talk, because our salterns are close to the path. We run two salterns, one with sixteen salt pans, and a second one with ten salt pans, near Les Perles Pond. Winter is a slack period. From November to February, the saltern is flooded in order to be protected from gales and storms. However, I like strolling there and seeing how it’s going. At that time, you very rarely come across anyone there, apart from birds... Little egrets, herons, terns and gulls are wintering quietly. Starting in February, depending on weather conditions, you slowly empty the saltern until the *vettes*, the small clay paths inside, become exposed. The grass is green and high, the saltern is very beautiful at that time.

EVERY MINUTE COUNTS



Reconditioning the saltern is a busy and stressful period, for we are dependent on weather conditions. You have to clean up the saltern, remove the algae and silt that have accumulated at the bottom of the salt pans, rebuild the small paths that have collapsed... People walking about are often surprised at all the work that needs to be done before being able to harvest the first grain of salt. I always try to make them more sensitive to this superb but very fragile environment. In summertime, I don’t have time to stop: every minute counts to harvest salt. When the season starts, we’re in the saltern from dawn to sunset. Some people are already there with their easels to make watercolours, take pictures, watch birds or run. It’s always a surprise seeing the colours that the sky has in store for us, every day is different.”

THE KEYS OF NATURE

To allow you to make the most of Noirmoutier’s rich nature, the Tourist Office has published a very complete *Nature Guide*. You will find in it a presentation of the Gois, the insects and shellfish of the foreshore, the fauna and flora, the birds, a short introduction to the island flavours. Five routes for walks, from 6.5 to 15.1 km, complement the document.





SEASON'S VEGGIES

Almost every summer day, Freddy and his wife unpack their fruits and vegetables on the markets of Noirmoutier-en-l'Île and Barbâtre.

“On Mondays, Fridays and Sundays, from April to September, we sell at the market of Noirmoutier-en-l'Île, and Wednesday mornings at the market of Barbâtre. We produce part of what we sell, mainly red fruits, but also tomatoes, peppers, aubergines, cucumbers and French beans. In summertime, we come very early, since we start to build our stall as early as 5:30 am. We take care to display our vegetables and our fruits attractively by playing with colours. It makes quite an impression, some people stop specially to take pictures of them. The first customers arrive around 8:00 am, or even 7:30 am when the day is likely to be very hot. We have holidaymakers, regulars, but also working people. Families generally come separately. You see first the grandparents, the parents, and then those with young children.

FRIENDLY MEETING PLACE

From 10:30 am until 1:00 pm, it's really crowded! Some walk around all the stalls to look at the prices, others are just taking a stroll and enjoying the atmosphere. People are looking more and more for small producers and are not put off if a fruit has a defect or a peculiar shape, on the contrary! For them, it's a sign of quality. They ask us a lot about our produce, their seasonality, the way of cooking them, whether the French beans have strings... We don't hesitate, either, to have them taste. Sometimes, we see grandparents turning up by bike with family and teaching their grandchildren to recognise fruit or not to touch them. In Noirmoutier-en-l'Île as in Barbâtre, the atmosphere is very friendly. People come across their neighbours or friends and invite each other to aperitif in front of us. Sometimes some bring us a jar of jam made with fruit we've grown or a cake.”



TAKE YOUR TIME

On Noirmoutier Island, it's time to leave your car at rest too and take time to discover the landscapes by bike. Many road improvements make it possible for the whole family to move around in complete safety. The tourist map of Noirmoutier Island also offers three discovery circuits: *Between beaches and harbours* to the north, with the Bois de la Chaise wood and the jetty, *Between marshes and windmills* on the Atlantic coast, with the oyster-farming harbour and the salterns, and *Between Gois and forests*, with the polder and the south sea wall.

A former sailing instructor, Marion has converted her little family to the pleasures of yachting.

“With my husband, we have a small boat moored in the Morin harbour. More often than not, we go on family sailing outings with our kids, Margot, twelve years of age, and Lucien, seven years of age. We trained them to take part in manoeuvres: they especially help us pull up and down the fenders, these small buoys protecting the boat hull against shocks. When the sea is glassy, with no wind, and the temperatures are sufficient, we equip them with sailing overalls and we tow them on a water tube. They love it! Sometimes, we also go diving with masks and tubas off the Morin harbour. Water is transparent, making it possible to see seaweed and fish. In calm weather, sea outings are real moments of relaxation. Every time we go out sailing, I look at the coast. I'd like to be a painter to draw everything I see: the island that you can embrace over kilometres, the morning colours or the colours of the setting sun, the plane trails in the sky, the shapes of clouds... Near the coastline, the curry scent of the immortelle growing on the dunes is also a reminder to us of some of our distant travels.

**FAMILY
ESCAPE**

**BETWEEN OCEAN
AND BOURGNEUF BAY**



When we go fishing, everyone in the family has one's little fishing rod. I take care of fitting them with hooks and baits, but the kids do throw and rewind their own lines. When there's a fish at the end, we take over with my husband and the kids pick up the landing net. They are often those catching the biggest fishes, but they don't particularly like touching them when these are wriggling about... Off the islet of Le Pilier, we can find cuttlefish. The kids are always much impressed on seeing the ink it spits out. It gets all over the boat! To take a pause in a day at sea which may be long for them, we bathe, and we always take with us a good picnic and an afternoon snack..."

LEARNING THE OCEAN

The island has all the necessary facilities to allow children—and parents!—to discover the marine environment and water sports under the best conditions: the younger ones will start from four years of age with the Garden of the Seas before getting into sailing (optimist dinghy, from seven years of age) in different forms—sailing dinghies, catamarans, sailboards, sand yachts... Many other sensations, from the sweeter to the saltier ones, are also on the menu: stand up paddle boarding, sea kayaking, tube towing, water skiing, kitesurfing...



SEAFOOD PLATTERS

A regular presence on the island beaches, H el ene has always been fascinated by oyster-farming activities.

“It’s an image from my childhood that comes back to me every time I go to La Court Beach in La Gu erini ere to take the sun or when I ride my bike near Les Sableaux Beach in Noirmoutier-en-l’ le. At high tide, you can’t distinguish anything special... But when the sea recedes, little black dots appear in the distance. The foreshore slowly reveals its secret: you gradually discover that these are the perfectly well-aligned stakes on which mussels are grown... These unusual rows make up a singular geometry: as a child, I wondered what they might be used for. At spring tides, they are completely uncovered. It then looks like a strange forest that still fascinates me today... The oyster-farming tables are just as intriguing, closer to the beach and completely inconspicuous under water at high tide. They also form a weird-looking paving when the water recedes.

TWO WORLDS

The arrival of tractors on the slipway creates an amusing contrast, an unexpected encounter between the holiday world and the terroir world. The trailers backed down to the water’s edge make it possible to launch flat barges. On board, the mussel farmers reach the stakes around which they wound the socks containing the mussel spat. By means of a metal sock at the end of an articulated boom, they recover mussels reaching maturity. The shellfish are at once put into multicoloured tanks you can distinguish on the barge decks. This surprising ballet a few strokes away from the bathers is a show I still don’t get tired of. Lying on my towel, I can spend hours contemplating it.”



TASTING TIME

After theory, do not hesitate to move on to practice! In the harbour of Le Bonhomme, for instance, you have now many oyster farmers complementing their cabins with oyster bars to offer visitors, bikers or hikers passing by a little tasting session of their shellfish. How nice it is to enjoy the setting sun on a terrace while savouring a few oysters just taken out of the water...

Aboard the *Côte d'Émeraude*, his liner-potter, Freddy Pineau criss-crosses the ocean in search of well-targeted species.

"For thirty years, I've been fishing only what I've been looking for. The line allows for very selective fishing, which is therefore more respectful, but also very qualitative. From September to December, I'm also tracking down sea bass. Depending on our fishing zone, sometimes we have to leave L'Herbaudière at 2:00 am, because the lines have to be laid before daybreak. It takes us about one hour and a half to lay them and four to haul up all of them... We weigh them down with sinkers and we bait with sandeels, small crabs or cuts of cuttlefish which must be very fresh. Sunrise at sea is always magical, it also signals that fishing can start. It is imperative to comply with hours allowed for sea bass fishing: if it's a miss in the morning, you cannot make up for it at night. When there's swell, fishing is generally better, because the fish move around more. When getting back, it's always a pleasure finding the quays crowded with onlookers looking out for the return of the fishermen..."

OCEAN
MARINADES

SEA BASS, PINK SEA BREAM OR POLLOCK



We also catch pink sea bream and pollock on the lines, but no gilthead sea bream which is caught with nets. From January to March, we focus on conger eel that loves rocky coasts. It has the advantage of biting at any time, day or night. In April, we make a small alteration on the boat in order to change the lifting device, because we switch to pots. The fishing season for lobster, spider crab and brown crab extends through September. Here too, you need bait. Lobster, for instance, is a scavenger and enjoys fish waste. In Noirmoutier, the fleet chiefly consists of medium-sized boats like mine. Boats under 9 metres rather practise seasonal fishing focusing on shrimps, red mullet and shellfish. A few trawlers focus their fishing on scallops in Bourgneuf Bay and monkfish."

CHAMPION... OF QUALITY

With some sixty boats, L'Herbaudière is the main fishing harbour on the island, the second one in the Vendée, all species combined, and France's second one for sole. A former major sardine harbour, nowadays it specialises in noble species: sole, sea bream, red mullet, pollock, anglerfish, conger eel, cuttlefish, along with line-caught sea bass... It is also a major harbour for spiny lobster, lobster, spider crab, crabs and shrimps...



EARLY FLAVOURS

A freshly retired potato grower, Jean-Pierre Tessier is a fine expert in this tuber that makes the reputation of Noirmoutier Island.

“It’s at the end of the 19th century that the potato really took its place on the island. Until then, the peasants mainly grew grain to pay for their farm rents and some potatoes for their personal consumption. They made their own plants or brought them back from their trading with other regions. On Noirmoutier Island, the houses bear witness to these traditions with their outside stairs along the gables to access attics. It’s there that the plants were placed, as the heat rising from the hearth helped them sprout. Gradually, the best soils in the north of the island, between L’Herbaudière, Le Vieil and the Bois de la Chaise wood, became reserved for potatoes. They grow almost everywhere. But to be fine-looking, well-rounded with a thin skin, you need sandy soil that warms up better.”

A UNIQUE PRODUCE

Certain varieties, very widespread in the past, have disappeared, such as the Saint-Jean which personally I never knew. Others have been revived, especially the Bonnotte because it really has a special taste. It had been introduced to Noirmoutier Island, coming from Normandy, in the Interwar Period, and then more or less abandoned in the nineteen sixties in favour of Sirtema, simpler to harvest. Indeed, it takes twice more time with the Bonnotte, because you don’t gather it, you pluck it off: all the potatoes remain attached to the mother plant, somewhat like grapes! With its microclimate, the island is also fortunate to be spared from spring frosts and can consequently offer several varieties of early potatoes before anyone else. Besides, they have this little sweet taste much sought-after, thanks to the seaweed on which they grow and to sea spray.”



COUNTRY BELLES

There is not just one Noirmoutier potato, but Noirmoutier potatoes! Besides the famous Bonnotte, exclusive to the island, available a few short weeks in May, four other early varieties are the delight of the markets, namely the early spring Sirtema, the Lady Christ’l and the Esmeralda, harvested in early May, and the Charlotte, from June. Some later varieties also stand out, such as the Aminca, the Délicatesse, the Roseval, the Belle-de-mai, the Désirée and the Annabelle.
