Memory of craft and flavour

*An Island of
Remarkable Food Heritage*

Since 2023, Noirmoutier has been awarded the prestigious "Site Remarquable du Goût" (Remarkable Taste Site) label. This national distinction celebrates the exceptional products born from this unique territory: the island's early potatoes, fleur de sel sea salt, oysters and sole. Each flavour carries the legacy of those who cultivate, harvest and pass down their expertise from generation to generation.



Finding yourself again also means taking the time to savour. Closing your eyes and letting these pure flavours unfold on your tongue, the ones of a land that remind us of our very first summers.



The Oyster

If your island escape had a flavour, it would be that of a freshly harvested oyster. Its delicate flesh and briny taste bring the full power of the ocean to your palate. Enjoyed natural, with a squeeze of lemon, a touch of shallot vinegar, or simply on buttered bread sprinkled with sea-salt crystals, everyone rediscovers their own cherished ritual. Here, oyster farming is an art that has been cultivated with passion for decades. At the Port du Bonhomme, oyster farmers sell their oysters directly, alongside the treasures gathered by shore fishermen: razor clams, periwinkles and other delicious shellfish.

The Potato

“A rediscovery for some, a first time culinary experience for others, the early potatoes of Noirmoutier always win hearts... and taste buds. On the island, five varieties are grown each year between March and July. Together, they represent nearly 9,000 tonnes of production, harvested and then sold on the island and across France through the cooperative of Noirmoutier. Among them, one stands as a true icon: the Bonnotte. Harvested before full maturity, this small early potato has become Noirmoutier’s signature speciality. Its secret?

The oceanic climate, the influence of sea spray and of course, goémon: a blend of brown seaweed gathered after storms and used for more than a century as a natural fertilizer by the island’s 22 farming families. Personally, I love it simply sautéed in butter with a pinch of Noirmoutier fleur de sel, served with beautiful sardines. At home or in a restaurant, always a delight!”

Sea salt and fleur de sel

On the island, it is known as “white gold”. Far from being an everyday commodity, Noirmoutier’s fleur de sel glistens on the surface of the salt marshes that cover a large part of the island. It is undoubtedly one of the island’s oldest and most emblematic traditions. Salt workers still follow ancestral methods, harvesting coarse sea salt and delicate fleur de sel by hand, helped by generous sunshine and a gentle, constant breeze. They patiently watch for the crystals to form, adjust the water levels, and carefully gather what the sea and time offer them. At the cooperative or directly from the producers, visitors can take home this gift of nature - a good way to prolong the taste of the island long after the journey ends.



The cooperatives, guardians of craft and flavour

Since 1997, four producer cooperatives have joined forces under the association “Flavours of Noirmoutier Island” to protect what defines the island’s identity: ancestral know-how and authentic taste.

Each cooperative preserves a specific expertise:

- sea salt harvested by hand by around one hundred salt workers*
- early potatoes grown by 22 producers*
- oysters farmed for two to three years by around forty oyster farmers*
- premium fish caught at sea by a fleet of around one hundred fishing boats*

Together, they ensure traditional methods are passed down, safeguard the independence of local producers and perpetuate the authentic taste of Noirmoutier.





The Fish

“At L’Herbaudière, the fish auction is the meeting place for seafood lovers. There’s something special about this place, whether you’ve known it all your life or you’re discovering it for the first time. As for me, I was a fisherman for 40 years. I first went to sea on my father’s boat in 1988 before having a boat of my own.

Around Noirmoutier, we fish with nets for the noble species found in these waters: sole, sea bream and pollack. Line-caught sea bass accounts for about 80% of our catch. We also trap a few lobsters between May and August. Today, with climate change, lesser known but highly prized new species are appearing off our coasts, such as octopus or meagre. Every morning we head out in search of fish, mindful that the ocean is a treasure that must be protected. Back in the harbour, the catch goes to the fish auction, where fishmongers compete to buy the finest specimens. On market stalls, these freshly landed catches adorn local tables and inspire the island’s chefs.”

Discovery:

Sea bass tartare with seaweed

Quentin, who lives in Noirmoutier-en-l'Île, has two passions: cooking and spearfishing. His signature Noirmoutier-inspired recipe celebrates the richness of the island's local produce.

Serves 4

Ingredients:

600 g line-caught sea bass • 4 tsp lemon zest (yellow or green) • 4 tsp soy sauce • 4 tbsp sunflower oil • 4 tsp sugar • 4 tbsp cider vinegar • 4 shallots • 4 tsp finely chopped red onion • 4 capers • Parsley • 12 sprigs of Laurencia seaweed (about 12 g, gathered from the foreshore of the Bay of Bourgneuf) • 2 tsp freshly grated ginger • Juice of one lemon • Espelette pepper

Preparation:

Pick the Laurencia seaweed on the foreshore at low tide. Fillet the sea bass and cut it into small cubes (less than 1 cm). Marinate the fish in lemon juice in the refrigerator for 20-30 minutes, then drain. Sauté the finely sliced shallots in the oil for about 3 minutes, then add the vinegar, sugar and strips of lemon zest. Let it caramelize for about 10 minutes. Finely chop the seaweed, parsley, red onion and capers. Grate the ginger. Gently combine the fish with the sauce and all the condiments, then add the soy sauce. Serve in bowls with a pinch of Espelette pepper.

Serve with sticky rice with a Japanese-style sauce: 12 cl sesame oil, 12 g grated ginger, 20 cl sweet or regular soy sauce. Mix and serve with the tartare.





Thrill and Freedom

On the water

The island becomes your playground. Here, you rediscover the pure freedom of letting yourself be carried by the elements and feeling the power of the wind. Kitesurfing in the Bay of Bourgneuf, paddleboarding facing the picturesque village of Le Vieil, sailing off the coast of L'Herbaudière, sand yachting along the vast beaches of Barbâtre, each activity offers its own rush of adrenaline. Follow your instincts, try everything, move from one water sport to another and rediscover that exhilarating feeling of being fully alive.

DISCOVERIES: 3 MAGICAL CYCLING DETOURS

Between beaches and harbours (19.2 km)

This northern loop starts in Noirmoutier-en-l'Île and leads you to the Bois de la Chaise, known for its elegant seaside villas. It continues to the picturesque village of Le Vieil, with its fishermen's houses and iconic beach, where the first French submarine was once unveiled. The route then heads to L'Herbaudière, a fishing port whose boats marked "NO" (for Noirmoutier) supply some of the finest restaurants in France.

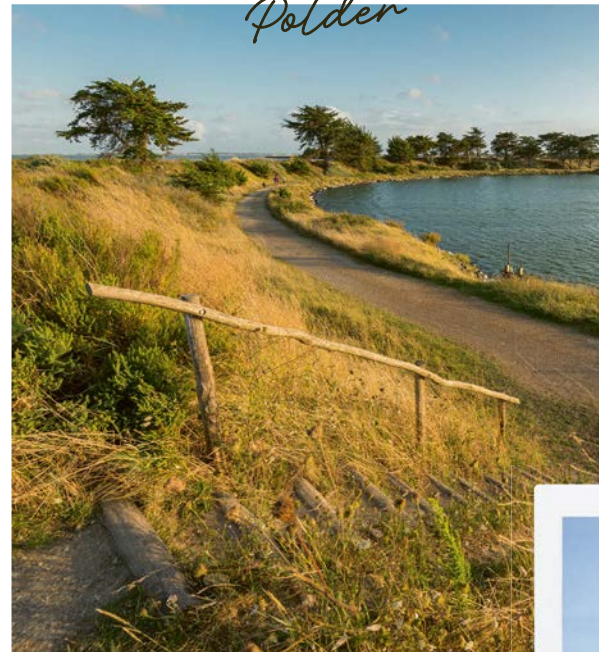
Between salt marshes and windmills (18.5 km)

Starting from l'Épine, this route crosses the salt marshes that cover a third of the island. It passes through Port de Morin, famous for its sunsets, then reaches the windmills that stand as timeless guardians of the landscape before arriving at Port du Bonhomme, a renowned centre of oyster farming. The return journey follows the salt marshes.

Between the Gois and the forests (23.3 km)

Starting from Barbâtre, this wild route leads you to the Passage du Gois, Europe's only tidal causeway, and the Sébastopol Polder, a nature reserve home to around 3,000 birds. The route then crosses the agricultural plain and its fields of early potatoes before diving into maritime pine forests and dunes.

In the quieter months, the island reveals one of its best-kept secrets. Located along a major migratory route, it becomes a refuge for tens of thousands of birds stopping over between northern Europe and Africa. In autumn, brent geese and Eurasian curlews arrive, faithful to their yearly rendezvous. With the return of sunny days, elegant avocets join them, dancing across the salt marshes, along with black-winged stilts on their long pink legs. With binoculars in hand, visitors rediscover the simple joy of observing, waiting patiently and marvelling at this precious natural spectacle.

In the streets

Strolling through the island of Noirmoutier is like listening to a long story, whose chapters unfold at every turn. Ocean-blue shutters, whitewashed walls and small gardens filled with hollyhocks, the island's houses leave an indelible mark on the heart. There is also the 12th-century medieval castle standing watch over the town, the elegant 19th-century villas, and the fishermen's villages facing the ocean where time seems to have stood still. By simply wandering where chance leads you, experience the freedom of living fully in the present moment.

Rediscover your wild side

"I first came to Barbâtre by chance, to go kitesurfing, and I fell in love with the landscapes. So much so that I decided to settle here! It's certainly the best spot on the island for all water sports enthusiasts: sailing, catamaran, sand yachting, and even foiling. The open waters of the Bay of Bourgneuf and the wide ocean beaches allow us to practise safely, in all conditions. What do I love most? The feeling of freedom, the rush of adrenaline, set against the raw, untamed nature of Noirmoutier Island."

On the wide beaches of Barbâtre, when the tide recedes, you reconnect with that childhood pleasure of searching for treasures in the wet sand. Here, the discovery is shrimp fishing with a chevrotière. It's a net mounted on a wooden frame, part of the island's living heritage, pushed in front of you through waist-deep water about an hour and a half before low tide. From May to mid-October, you slowly walk through the cool water, lift the chevrotière... and reveal your catch: grey and pink shrimp, fresh from the sea.

Discovery: Fleur de sel

The secret of gourmets and true connoisseurs? Fleur de sel. This treasure forms on the surface of the water as a delicate layer of crystals before being carefully harvested by the salt workers. It is sprinkled sparingly over a dish once it is plated. A gift from nature that you can buy directly from local producers or at the salt cooperative in Noirmoutier-en-l'Île.



L'Épine

Rediscover the art of contemplation

You can happily lose yourself in the charming little streets of L'Épine, with its picturesque atmosphere and flower-filled houses, just a few steps from the salt marshes. For generations, L'Épine has cultivated a gentle art of living, where people take the time to savour the simple pleasures of island life without rushing.

Perhaps a stroll through the local market to fill your basket with regional specialties, a quiet walk along the paths that border the salt marshes, the final pages of a novel read by the calm waters of Port de Morin, while watching the sunset ignite the horizon.

And for those who wish to admire the island from above, Bois des Éloux offers an unexpected retreat. Perched at the island's highest point, this maritime pine forest reveals shaded trails filled with the scent of resin. Around a bend in the path, the view suddenly opens onto the vast, ever-changing ocean, whose light shifts with the passing hours.

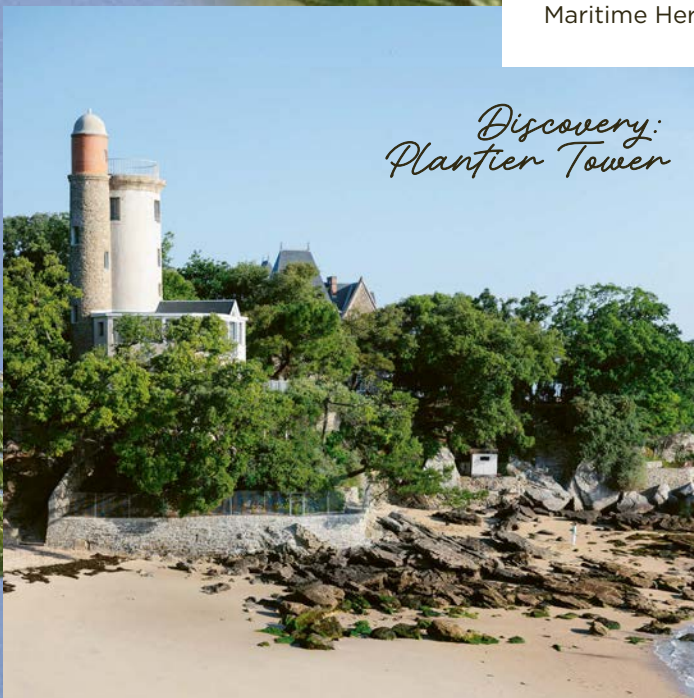
“It only takes a walk across its cobbled streets to sense its long and rich history. Already inhabited in Roman times, Noirmoutier-en-l'Île - the capital - has an old soul. This charming and picturesque town gradually took shape around several hamlets: Le Vieil, once the fishermen's quarter, L'Herbaudière, the trading port, and the town centre devoted to trade. Even today, despite the passing of time and changing lifestyles, these distinct atmospheres can still be felt throughout Noirmoutier-en-l'Île.

The Bois de la Chaise also witnessed an important chapter of history, when elegant seaside holiday villas were built to order near Plage des Dames, where fashionable bourgeois ladies once arrived by boat at the jetty.

While strolling through the centre of Noirmoutier-en-l'Île, you can easily discover remarkable traces of those bygone days: the D'Elbée and Jacobsen mansions, now transformed into a museum, as well as the medieval castle.”

During a walk along the beach of Anse Rouge, an unexpected silhouette appears among the holm oaks of Bois de la Chaise: two intertwined circular towers, one crowned with a rooftop terrace, the other with a dome, as if they had stepped straight out of a fairytale. This is Villa Plantier, the island's first holiday villa, built in 1861 by Louis-Joseph Plantier, a gifted civil engineer who designed several lighthouses on the Vendée islands. Stone and brick combine in this unusual architecture that heralded the beginnings of seaside tourism. A private residence, it reveals itself from the beach or from boats arriving from Pornic, like a well-kept secret that makes visitors lift their eyes in wonder.

“In La Guérinière, oysters are deeply loved. Oyster farming is part of the village’s very DNA. Many families here have been cultivating oysters for generations, and this know-how is proudly passed down. The oyster beds shape the landscape just as much as our identity. It’s not uncommon to hear locals talking about tides, harvests and seasons around a table or down at Port du Bonhomme. This harbour, simple and authentic, is the maritime soul of the village. Here, we share a visceral bond with the ocean. We adapt to its moods, wait for the right moment, and watch the landscape transform with the rhythm of the tides.”

La Guérinière

Rediscover your love of the ocean

*Discovery:
Louise’s boat trip*

La Guérinière hides a charming paved coastal path that runs along the ocean, where discoveries change with the rhythm of the tides. During a morning walk or run, you pass an old windmill, charming traditional houses and small streets full of character. At low tide, the landscape transforms completely. The oyster fields emerge, revealing a whole world that is usually hidden beneath the water.

"There is a corner of land where nature has preserved a kind of wild and contemplative grace. The holm oaks, their trunks twisted by the force of the ocean winds, form dark vaults through which, here and there, the dazzling light of the sea appears.
