Here's an island not short on air!*

Spring on Noirmoutier Island

This is a ritual: lifelong friends, Amandine, Paul, Lili, Romain, Raphy and Nico arrange for a spring stay every year. What could be better than a nature and heritage trip to get together...

We were in great need of this big weekend with friends! I don't know any more who talked about Noirmoutier Island, but everybody said yes immediately... Especially when Romain found this typical little house in La Guérinière, with its outside staircase, garden and sea view. It is big enough to accommodate the three couples... And even Movie, the dog of Nico and Raphy: he just loves the sea air!



• Castle Life

On Saturday morning, much discussion on the day's programme. Lili wants to see the castle. I like the idea, and so does Raphy... Girl power! We win the day. At the heart of Noirmoutier-en-l'Île, this perfectly preserved 12th-century castle dominates the town. It houses a museum on the island's history with a different exhibition every year. Magnificent 360° view from the castle keep: salterns, Müllembourg polder, Bourgneuf Bay ... Nothing escapes our eyes!

Let's stay in the cultural field: the Jacobsen mansion is very close. It's a fine 18th-century mansion house, belonging to a family you often come across here. According to our guide, these merchants who came from Dunkirk developed the polders, laid out the port and the pier, the parade ground in front of the castle... The recently restored house skilfully mixes period elements and contemporary style. It also houses the Maritime Heritage Centre which recounts the island's maritime history.

• Stroll and Picnic

It is mild, having breakfast on the terrace is the thing to do... For this first day, the sun makes us feel like going on a stroll: we pack the backpacks with the picnic and off we go. After having walked along La Cantine Beach, we walk up towards Les Eloux Wood, a pinewood where the sandy path is undulating... We quickly reach Le Pé-de-L'Herse, the island's highest point: 22 metres only, but a steep little climb all the same! Then, we reach Les Eloux Beach where we settle down for lunch... Armed with great courage, we decide to carry on via the coast to the harbour of Morin, a former mooring spot sheltered by sea walls for some twenty years... We quietly walk back, dazed, but invigorated by the air of the open sea.



• In the Salterns

Sunday, we take the bikes for a ride to the salterns that we quickly reach. We see the salt makers bustling about in preparation for the harvest. They are raising the paths with clay drawn from the salt pans the water of which they are also regulating by means of small boards. The ballet of migratory birds is impressive. And the mustard flowers provide a nice contrast to the ochre atmosphere of the salterns... It's magnificent! We settle down for lunch at the edge of a marsh creek. Continuing our ride towards the north of the island, we reach the potato fields where the harvest is in full swing... I'm careful not to reveal that tonight I'm going to cook the early Noirmoutier potatoes found at the market this morning! My very small *grenaille* potatoes, browned in the frying pan with their skins and just a pinch of salt-Noirmoutier salt, of course!-, are a huge success.



• Kayak Outing

What a good idea to have booked an additional day before going back home! And what a pity it would be not to enjoy the island in this season. This time, it's the boys who decide on the programme... They feel like exerting themselves! And so we set off for Bois de la Chaise for a sea kayak outing. The couples re-form on the boats... Of course, Nico and Romain want to have a race. Fortunately, we manage to talk them out of it: and so it's as boat trippers that we kayak along the fine beaches of Noirmoutier-en-l'île, off to explore the great period seaside villas... How not to dream?

We still have salty lips as we set off for home... Indeed, there's plenty of salt in our car boot, too. And we have scenery in our eyes. We don't feel at all like leaving... And we are already longing to return!

“Noirmoutier does not reveal itself at a glance. You have to let your eyes discover the typical little garden or the old building behind the hedge.”

“The island, its landscapes, its architecture have not changed much over the centuries. It has retained its wild character, and it's probably due to the islanders' temperament. You still have ancient sea walls in places, bearing testimony to their expertise in fighting off the sea. The buildings are conventional: low houses or two-storey houses with outside staircases and the lower part reserved for farm activities. Writer Marc Elder talks of the Noirmoutier inhabitants as peasants of the sea. Some fifteen windmills still remain, which may not be visited, but from the La Cour dune in La Guérinière, you can see four of them restored. On the island, the quality of light is incomparable. It reveals the heritage... It would be much less visible without it!”

Summer on Noirmoutier Island

This year for Hugo, Clara and their kids, it's an adventure and nature week between land and sea... And good times as a family and with friends.

"The island of Noirmoutieeeeeerrrrr!" What a reaction.... With Clara, we wanted to experience an unfamiliar place, without going too far away, it's just perfect. The idea of staying in the teepees of this campsite in Barbâtre excited our children very much. The fact is that it's different, very nature oriented, but also very cocoon. And discovering the ocean close at hand at wake-up is a sight I won't get tired of anytime soon.



• Starting Catamaran Sailing

No rest for the brave, we leave for the long beach of Le Midi. The morning sun is very pleasant. While the kids play, we make the most of our beach towels... With one eye on the horizon or the sand yachts in the distance: I feel pretty much like sand yachting!

After lunch, off we go! I have to meet my friend Etienne. He has a family house near La Clère Beach and he has invited me to go for a ride on a catamaran. Sheltered by the coast, we take advantage of a nice breeze. The rest of the tribe is spending the afternoon on that large beach. They are waving at us, but, seen from the sea, they look so small. Etienne has often explained to us that this island was for family and friends... It's true! And we already feel like at home.

• Between Market and Kitesurfing

Monday is market day in Barbâtre. Strolling among the stalls, that's a ritual I love on holiday! And on the island, there's no lack of markets: according to the guide, every day, there is a market in one of the four municipalities. Whatever side you look, your eye is caught: producers of salt, potatoes, very fresh fish and shellfish, mouthwatering French pastries... Smells, colours: with so many fine local produce, you feel like tasting everything!

I wanted for some time to try kitesurfing and here's the big day! New sensations in prospect: Julien, the instructor, takes us rigging the kites on a sandbank, just near the Gois. I'm off for two hours of water aerobics with a kite before Clara fetches me back in La Fosse... The kids are all excited, but a little disappointed that they've not seen me take off. Tonight, it's dinner with family under the stars. That's part of the holidays too and I need to recover...



• Old Sailing Boats

Today, Julien has considered that I could get on the kiteboard and quickly enough I make it. The sensation of sliding on the water, the fresh air on my face... It's great! Especially in this sublime setting of the bay with the Gois in the distance. Kitesurfing really is exhilarating and much less physical than it looks like. The kids are all proud of their dad... I get back to them under their applause and they ask me a thousand questions.

For a change in pace, we go on a stroll to L'Herbaudière. We have the opportunity to admire a fine old boat returning to the harbour where others are at anchor. I did not imagine that Noirmoutier Island had such a maritime heritage. We take time to discuss with the crewmen who explain to me that it's a Cognac, a wooden keelboat from the late Sixties. They are training for the Bois de la Chaise regattas in early August... I must definitely come back to see that!

• Hike in the Great Outdoors

On the advice of our campsite neighbours, we decide on a big hiking trip. The kids are delighted to go to the club where they have made friends. Off we go to the Sebastopol polder... There really are a lot of birds and it's a magnificent sight in the sun! We quickly reach the Gois entrance where a crowd has come to admire the road emerging with the ebbing tide. After a short break, we carry on to the south point, sometimes under the shelter of the sea wall, sometimes climbing on it to take time to enjoy the scenery of the bay. Magical! After passing under the bridge, we return quietly via the Atlantic coastline and the dune at the edge of the forest. What a contrast! The island is definitely as attractive on the landward side as on the seaward side!



• Thursday: One Heck of a Place

The final day already! We are to meet Etienne at noon in an oyster farmer's cabin in the harbour of Le Bonhomme [The Fellow]. It's one of the many places where you can taste oysters. The sun on the terrace, the panorama over the oyster ponds with the herons, avocets and egrets, the oysters just out of the water... It's as if time has come to a halt.

Too bad that's not the case, because the holidays are coming to an end. But with a huge urge to come back very soon!

"We do everything and this works fine for everyone! Bourgneuf Bay also enables activity off season, in spring or in autumn. Here, you can come across new boats as well as old sailing dinghies, along with a whole group of nice sailing boats, metric boats, Sharks, Dragons... This is diversity! The Noirmoutier Island regattas are over a century old. In the Eighties, some people got together to recreate them with traditional sailing boats. Little by little, the fleet grew and the regattas entered the official circuits. But this remains a very popular event, especially with the sailing up the harbour and the crews in fancy dress."

Autumn on Noirmoutier Island

I had promised H      a little getaway for us to recover from a very hectic return after the summer holidays. She had never come to Noirmoutier Island and I surprised her. For everything to be perfect, I booked a fine hotel with spa-I know that H      loves that kind of relaxation-in Noirmoutier-en-l'    and I chose one of the prettiest rooms. Superb surroundings, staff attending to every need... It's the dream setting!



• Marine Activities

In this season, Noirmoutier Island is really made for lovers. On the advice of the hotel receptionist, we get to La Gu      where it looks like the large beach of La Court has been reserved for us... Everything's quiet, time is taking its time. But this autumnal languor is far from being monotonous. All the less so as the sea retains all the heat accumulated this summer and the baths are delicious. We are taking advantage of this to discover sea wading: with water up to waist, water hiking is as invigorating an exercise as it is physical-much more so than I imagined-excellent for the heart and for breathing. And after an hour's effort, it's even nicer to go back and lie down on your bath towel!

• Spa Cocooning

To get off to a good start with our stay, I have taken care to book a spa ritual... The duo booth allows us to share this moment: body wrap, massage, we let go for two hours while exchanging understanding glances. Won over by the experience, I suggest at once scheduling another spa treatment before our departure. And Helen doesn't need to be coaxed!

We decide to extend this bubble of softness on L'Anse-Rouge Beach. Rocked by the soft surf of the sea, it's just magical! To finish the day on a high note, we go to dine at a fine establishment of the island. And there, we hesitate between sole and lobster, both caught that very morning... We've been won over by this first day.



• The Surprises of Nature

This mild atmosphere is conducive to strolling. Today, we decide on walking up the long Jacobsen jetty from the heritage harbour to reach Fort Larron. We can look over the M     bourg nature reserve, this area reclaimed from the sea, a refuge for many species. Indeed, we come across a few birds. But we mainly see donkeys grazing quietly. We walk on via Les Sableaux Beach, Les Dames Beach... We push on to Les Souzeaux before walking back via the pathways in the Bois de la Chaise wood, lined with beautiful houses over a century old. How peaceful and quiet it is in these varied and preserved landscapes... After strolling for two hours, we're glad to get back to the spa waiting for us for another care treatment. This time, we take time to also take advantage of the hammam. I definitely love that place!



• Great Gourmet Moment

For our last day, we decide on extending our exploration by bike. We ride off towards the salterns. The season is ending. A salt maker explains to us that these are the last *tirures* (salt raked up from the salt pans) of the season. It's also time for the *coloï*: before flooding their salt pans for winter, the producers bring their harvests to the cooperative and make a huge heap of white gold grow in front of the building. An exciting discussion...

We reach L'Herbaudière as the night is falling down to witness a blazing sunset in Luzérone, facing the Atlantic. Taking advantage of that beautiful atmosphere, I give Hélène a last surprise. A few months ago, I took care to book, on the sly, of course, a table in the Michelin-starred establishment on the harbour... What a pleasure seeing her eyes sparkling in front of these magnificent dishes!

Time flies too fast and the interlude comes to a close. But I'm sure that the memory of these beautiful moments of complicity will accompany us for a long time. Noirmoutier Island is not that far away... We'll be back quickly, that's for sure!

"In autumn, it's quiet once the salterns have been flooded. There are very few people. I go every day to the salterns. They are my gobet.*"

"It's the period when we can let up after the harvest. You can no longer see the paths. Still, we must watch over and prevent overfilling. Sometimes, you can see swans in that season: it's the sign of a good water quality. On the island, we work with nature and at its own pace, even though it's the salterns that are steering us. There's a real quality of life. All the same, it's fantastic to start with sea water and end up with salt and its flower. The Noirmoutier salt is a natural salt, the best one according to some. It chiefly has matchless whiteness. And it all comes from technique: I rake up the salt very slowly, it's a token of quality. The fleur de sel salt is very fine and the cooking salt very white."

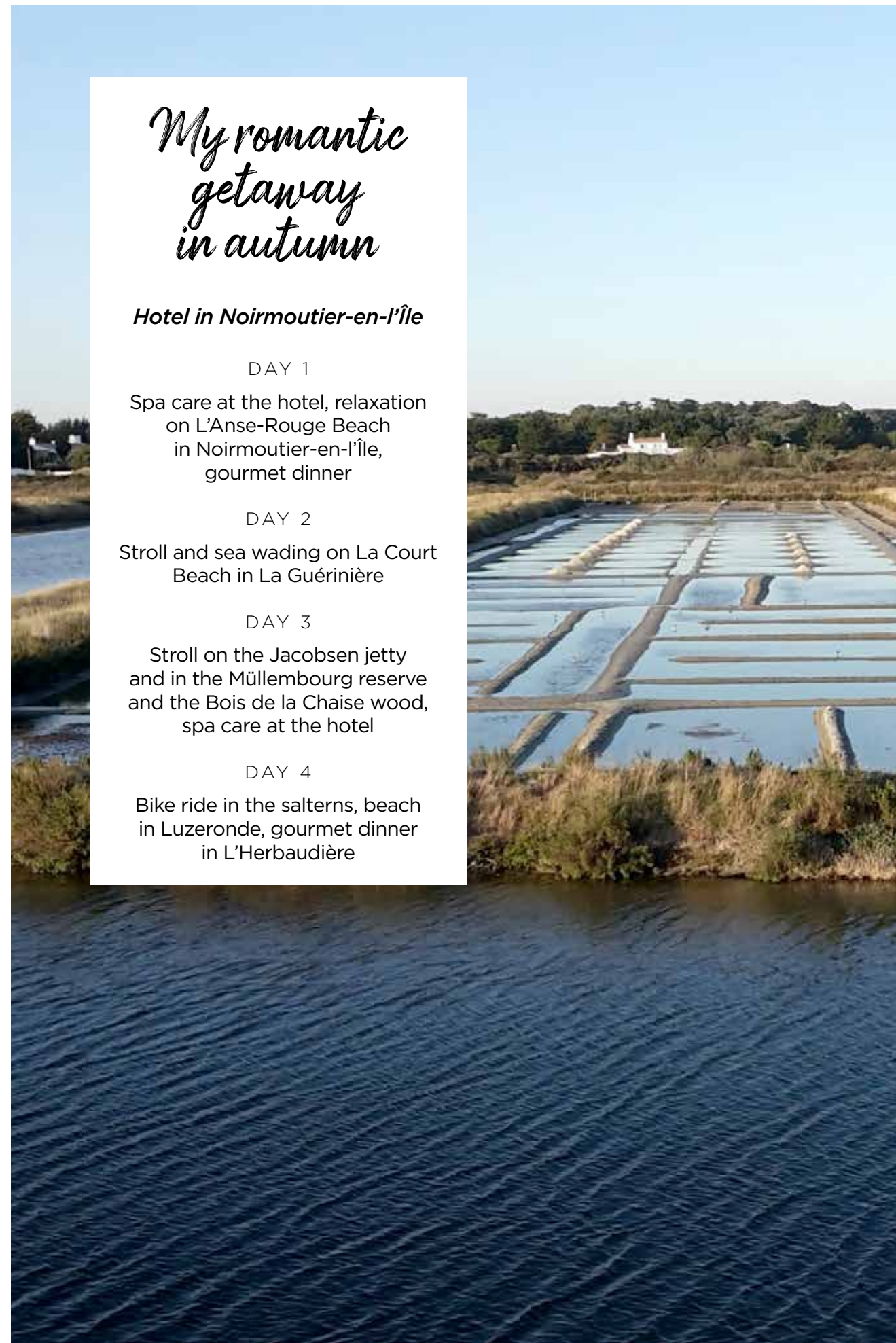

Winter on Noirmoutier Island

Being lovers of preserved great outdoors, Juliette and Pauline have organised a little break just for the two of them and are making nice discoveries.

We made up our minds at the last moment, as usual. "A weekend between girls in Noirmoutier just before New Year's Day, you feel like it, my Juju?" Of course, I feel like it!

So off we went... And, best of all, we arrived well: just in time to cross the Gois at low tide. In this season, with the cold sun that shines today, the famous submersible road is even more impressive. The causeway shines like a new pin and the flocks of birds swirl around in the clear sky... I love it!



• Oh! My Boat...

We immediately settle down in the guest room of L'Epine. The owners welcome us warmly and give us plenty of advice. The beach is very close. Close enough, indeed, to get a toe wet while admiring the setting sun! To celebrate our arrival, we're treating ourselves to a little jaunt to Noirmoutier-en- l'Île... And a waffle with whipped cream while strolling on the harbour. It's rather mild for the season and there are still people outside. We especially discover the *Martroger III*, all illuminated for the Christmas period. We learn from a very sweet Noirmoutier inhabitant that this beautiful wooden boat, listed as a historical monument, is a symbol of the island, representing it during heritage boat gatherings. It was used for 58 years to retrieve buoys and maintain beacons between Yeu Island and Noirmoutier Island before being restored thanks to a team of enthusiasts.

• All the Suns... and All the Birds

Big sun for our first full day: we definitely have much luck with the weather. Both very keen on birds, we unanimously decide on going for a walk in the nature reserve of the Sebastopol polder. Over 200 bird species of all kinds are found in this exceptional area... Many of them come here to rest and find shelter for winter. A lot of terns and waders... With our binoculars, we are lucky enough to spot a few avocets and black-tailed godwits. We really have to come back in spring when couples form!

The hot chocolate of the afternoon snack is well deserved after that afternoon in the open air. Then, we rush off for dinner at the restaurant and enjoy a delicious line-caught sea bass. The fish is, of course, very fresh and the salt had not far to go either!



• Mimosa Island

This Sunday, the sun is still there. We leave by bike with the intent of reaching Le Vieil and of following the coastline. "*I would like so much to live with you on your mimosa island,*" Barbara sung. In the alleys, the scent of mimosa trees is overwhelming us and the little yellow balls are bursting on the white walls. On the coast, it's the big breath of fresh air. After La Madeleine Beach, we have to leave the shore and walk around the old abbey. We then discover the vast fields where especially the famous *bonnottes* are harvested. In this period, the farmers are preparing their soil. The furrows are very neat, regularly cleaned by swarms of seagulls.

- We find again the ocean at La Linière Beach before quietly reaching L'Herbaudière. Leaving our bikes, we follow the strollers walking to the far end of the harbour. There, we pass by another remarkable boat: the *O'Abandonado*, a former Portuguese scow used for salt transport and converted into an excursion boat. In the warm-weather months, it especially enables to reach the island of Le Pilier. It's the one we can make out off the coast with its two lighthouses. A friendly inhabitant—indeed, they all are!—explains to us that the island, set 4.5 km from L'Herbaudière, is uninhabited and that it belongs to the Conservatoire du littoral [coastal protection agency]. Several bird species such as the common eider and the European rock pipit indeed come there to nest.

We must already think of going back home... My proposal of taking the Gois again is, of course, accepted. A nice salty picture to bring to a close this quite invigorating weekend. When are we coming back?

"Here, it's a magical season: the saltern land, the mist, the grazing light of the sun... It creates reflections of colours which I find fascinating. I also love the beach when nobody has set foot on the sand. The sea cleans it and leaves its tidemarks. The colour of the sand is never the same, and neither are the light and the wind. The birds, the serene atmospheres, the sunsets... You can never get bored. Finally, the Gois is a continuous show. Two hours before the tide recedes, everything is calm, and then the sounds keep increasing with the current. You can hear the sand breathe: there are plenty of little gurgles produced by the sandworms, shellfish, clams. When I cross the Gois, I feel like returning to my nest, leaving my life on the mainland behind me..."

Bois de la Chaise, cradle of the seaside resort. Beaches punctuated with white beach cabins and quiet coves. Our guides invite you first to a lovely walk along a magnificent coast, planted with holm oaks. On Noirmoutier Island, tourism was born here, amidst the alleys bordered with some ninety bourgeois houses of the nineteenth century. Dive into the days when the Ladies went seabathing...



The historic heart of the island lies in Noirmoutier-en-l'Île, with the heritage harbour, the medieval castle, the church and its famous crypt, witnesses to History, and to the Wars of the Vendée. The alleys of the founding Banzeau district bear the traces of the first inhabitants of the island.



Le Vieil, a typical village of Noirmoutier Island, is divided into a maze of alleys, lined with low walls of dry stone. Here, houses were put up on the beach, the Mardi-Gras house is a famous one, and nothing lets you guess its little history...



The famous Gois Passage and the nature reserve of the Sebastopol polder. Between this almost mythical site and the 132 hectares of the nearby polder, what is deciphered here is a whole natural world, quite outstanding: tide phenomenon, territory with several hundred species of the maritime fauna and flora.



L'Epine shelters the Morin harbour, a little getaway to the ocean. The visit starts on its sea wall, it focuses on the natural site and its riches, the salt, coastal fishing. The route runs along the Le Devin road bordering the sea, to the salterns living on it. Here, man had to tame nature and build defences against the assaults of the sea.

All these visits and others still are presented to you on **the website of the Noirmoutier Island Tourist Office.**

Download the app "Île de Noirmoutier Aventures" and follow the tracks of Louise the Otter for nice playful and educational walks in the form of treasure hunts.

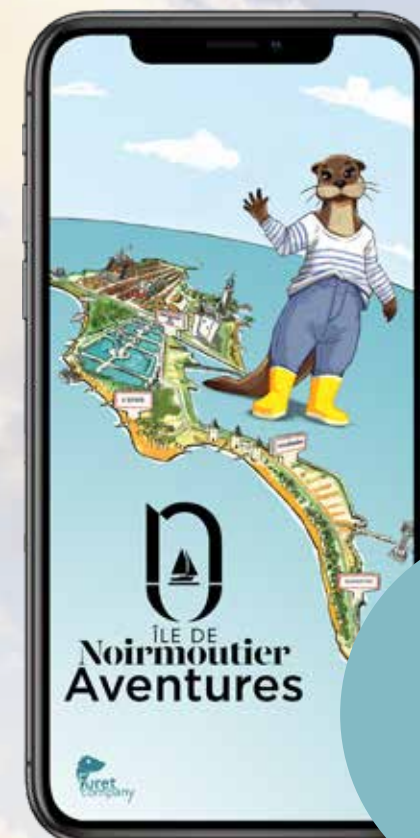

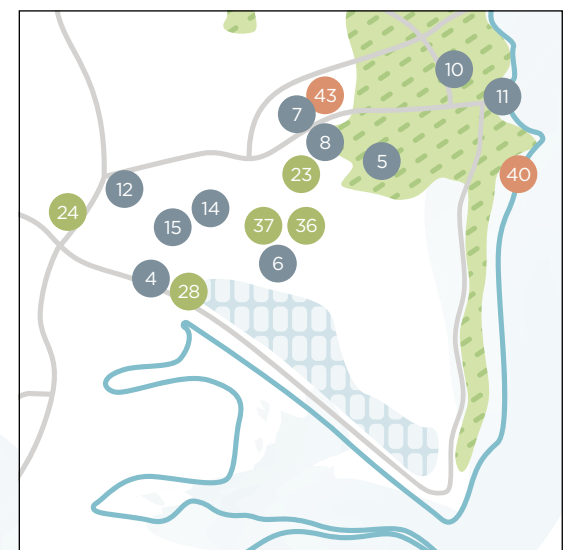
